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Grand Knight's Message



Dear Brother Knights, Family Members,
and Honored Clergy,

Our council's installation of officers for the 2014 – 2015 fraternal year was just concluded, and some of the officers attended the State level presentation of this fraternal year's Ohio Knights of Columbus programs and initiatives. We are slowly gearing up for this upcoming new year and looking forward to serve our church and community with a renewed commitment to our order's programs. Our main events this month will be our participation in the annual Parish Picnic and we are looking forward to our end of the year celebration

graciously hosted, once again, by Tom and Christine Foos.

Many of you are aware of the ultrasound initiative that was led by our Worthy State of Ohio Culture of Life director, Gary Anderson, during the past few months in support of a new machine for the Pregnancy Decision Health Center facility in Franklinton, better known as the Bottoms of the city of Columbus. This location is being brought into service to counter the Planned Parenthood abortion facility also in that neighborhood. Planned Parenthood always preys on the lower-income women for their customer base – notice that all Planned Parenthood facilities are always in these areas of any metropolitan city and that blacks and hispanics are a disproportionate, in terms of population, percentage of abortions (larger than their norm in society). But I digress.

Gary was able to work with Supreme and rally councils in the Greater Columbus Chapter to participate and donate monies

toward the purchase of this machine. With the help of Knights Of Columbus Supreme paying half the cost, and our local chapter providing the balance, a new machine will be on its way soon to the new PDHC agency! This campaign went so well that the chapter collected \$5,000 above the established goal! Praise the Lord. I am very proud to say that our council was able to donate \$2,125 to this effort - \$1,300 from council funds and the balance from individual contributions of members. This is awesome.

However, no rest for the weary. The Women's Care Center, partially due to a successful fund raising event this year, has finalized plans to open up a branch on the OSU campus. A great location to reach out, and be a life supporting resource, to the students who experience unplanned pregnancies. I am aware that WCC has been talking about this for over two years, and they have just recently reached out to the Knights of Columbus for an ultrasound machine as well.

During our budget discussions last month, the council officers endorsed a proposal to support the WCC ultrasound effort and have budgeted funds for this purpose. We are looking forward to further the culture of life with our support of WCC in their new location.
