This abortion facility has been the location for most of our recent 40 Days for Life campaigns. Many others have also spent personal time praying individually or in small groups at this clinic. Our council has been actively praying at this abortion shop every first Saturday for over two and a half years (coming up to three years in October). Everyone involved in prayer for the end of operations at this abortuary is thankful, relieved, and truly amazed at the power of prayer in faith. Hallelujah!

Our council will now seek another location to do our monthly prayer vigil. This will be discussed at our next monthly business meeting. One very strong candidate is Founder's clinic on Broad Street – one of the largest here in town and

the site for a recent 40 Days for Life campaign.

Along with the Cleveland Ave location closing, there is word of another one in the city of Cleveland that has closed as well. There are now nine abortuaries left in Ohio. Let us continue to pray for the closing of all clinics and for the end of this terrible scourge on our nation.
