Grand Knight's Message



Dear Brother Knights and Honored Clergy,

Pope Francis has provide the following words of wisdom regarding civil dialogue:

“Indeed, we are a single human family that is journeying on toward unity, making the most of solidarity and dialogue among peoples in the multiplicity of differences. (5/24/13)”

“When leaders in various fields ask me for advice, my response is always the same: dialogue, dialogue, dialogue. The only way for individuals, families and societies to grow, the only way for the life of peoples to progress, is via the culture of encounter, a culture in which all have something good to

give and all can receive something good in return. Others always have something to give me, if we know how to approach them in a spirit of openness and without prejudice. This open spirit, without prejudice, I would describe as “social humility”, which is what favors dialogue. Only in this way can understanding grow between cultures and religions, mutual esteem without needless preconceptions, in a climate that is respectful of the rights of everyone. Today, either we take the risk of dialogue, we risk the culture of encounter, or we all fall; this is the path that will bear fruit. (7/27/13, Leaders)”

“It is impossible for peace to exist without dialogue. All the wars, all the strife, all the unsolved problems over which we clash are due to a lack of dialogue. When there is a problem, talk: this makes peace. (8/21/13) “

“It is not conflict that offers prospects of hope for solving problems, but rather the capacity for encounter and dialogue. (8/25/13)”

“I repeat forcefully: it is neither a culture of confrontation nor a culture of conflict which

builds harmony within and between peoples, but rather a culture of encounter and a culture of dialogue; this is the only way to peace. (9/1/13)”
