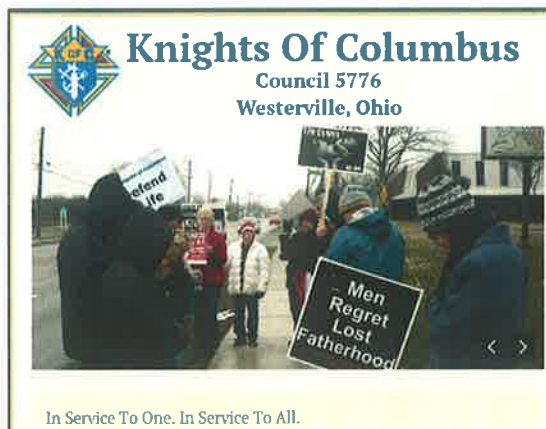

Grand Knight's Message

Dear Brother Knights and Honored Clergy,

The feast day of St. John Bosco was celebrated on Thursday January 31. Don Bosco was the Founder of the Salesians who are currently operating schools and missions around the world.

The Salesian Boys and Girls Club (80 Sixth Street) was built in 1927 as an Athletic Club, Auditorium and Headquarters for the Knights of Columbus. The building was acquired by the Salesian Society in 1968 and used as a Boys and Girls Club. The building was

last used by the Bosco Center until May 2017.

John Bosco educated the whole person—body and soul united. He believed that Christ's love and our faith in that love should pervade everything we do—work, study, play. For John Bosco, being a Christian was a full-time effort, not a once-a-week, Mass-on-Sunday experience. It is searching and finding God and Jesus in everything we do, letting their love lead us. Yet, because John realized the importance of job-training and the self-worth and pride that come with talent and ability, he trained his students in the trade crafts, too.

Salesian communities primarily operate shelters for homeless or at-risk youths; schools; technical, vocational, and language instruction centers for youths and adults; and boys' clubs and community centers.

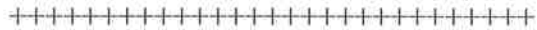

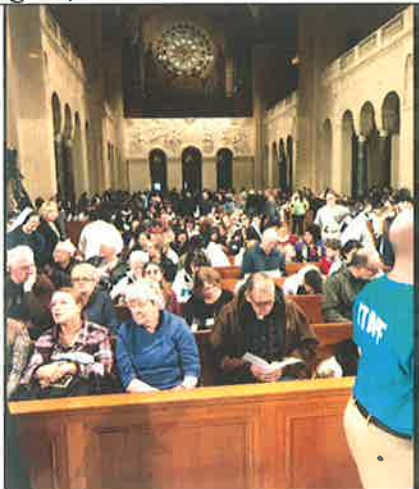

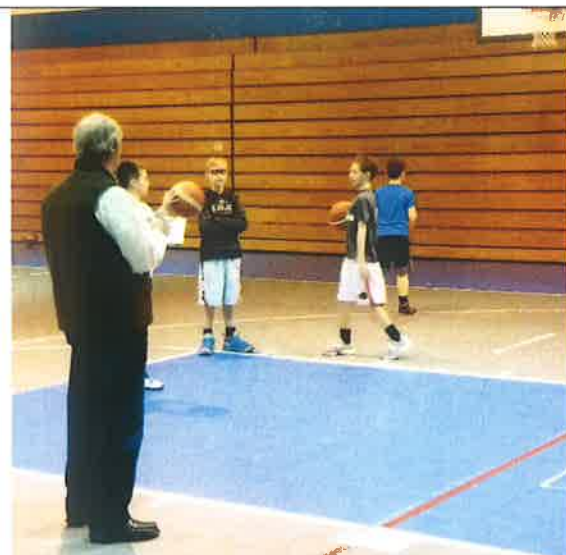
