Grand Knight's Message

Dear Brother Knights and Honored Clergy,

The following are excerpts from an article by Roxanne King, published in the National Catholic Register (June 9-11, 2019):

Kendrick Castillo was an extraordinary young man who did not hesitate to lay down his life for his fellow students just three days before graduating from STEM School Highlands Ranch in Littleton, Colorado on May 7, 2019.

During his funeral mass on May 17 at St. Mary's Church, Bishop Jorge Rodriguez, auxiliary bishop of Denver, said, "Kendrick gave everything he is and everything he had – family, a future, a degree, his life – so other young men and women could go back to their families, have a future, graduate and live."

"Only a young man with God in his heart and possessing a big, good heart can do what he did: to lay down his life to save his friends."

Kendrick's father, John, belongs to Council 4844. John and Kendrick gave 2,600 hours of community service to the Knights. Past Grand Knight Joseph Nguyen said that at his parish and school Kendrick exhibited the virtues of charity, unity, and fraternity the organization fosters and announced that he was given full knighthood by the KofC and enrolled in its prayer guild.


